President's Message

2020 continues to be a once in a generation year. Covid-19 is still strongly influencing all of our lives, although we are beginning to see some light at the end of the tunnel. Not sufficient light as yet to set dates for our AGM and Physical Federal Council Meetings. These could be held anytime between the end of September through to the end of November. There are many influences that will determine the final date. Some of the deciding factors are open travel between States without 14 days quarantine at either end of the trip; whether Perth and Hobart Royal go ahead as planned; whether our preferred venue in Adelaide are able to satisfy whatever rules the South Australian Government have in place for indoors meetings of more than 20, where those in attendance also need to eat. The August AGW should finally have definite dates for these meetings. There are three musts that we have to achieve – unless given permission from ASIC not to do so. They are we must hold an AGM in each calendar year. Normally this has to be held within 5 months of the end of our financial year, which normally means by the end of May. Currently ASIC have effectively given every company an extension of two months, ie the end of July. ASIC will review the need for further extensions in mid-June. Our Articles require us to hold a Physical Federal Council Meeting immediately following the AGM. Finally, our Regulations require that any motion relating to Regulation 1 that was tabled last year must be voted on this year. On a more positive note, Australia as a whole had its second driest year on record last year. A fact many would be painfully aware of.

Showing the perverse nature of this country we live in, so far this year we are tracking to have the third wettest year on record. Shades of Dorothea Mackellar. I hope that you are all getting your fair share of this rain.
